Waiver Release

Belle Plaine Summer Camp for boys and girls is held every summer for 6 consecutive weeks. We begin on Monday June 21 and end on Friday, July 30. Minicamp for 5 and 6 year-olds runs from June 29 to July 22 on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Hours of camp are 9:30 am to 2:30 pm. Minicamp hours are 9:30 am to noon.

There is no camp on July 3.

Who attends camp?

Children between the ages of 7 and 14 with an interest in art, movement, and most of all, having a great summer! Our average age for day camp is 10. Minicamp is offered for younger children of 5 or 6.

How many children attend your camp?

Our camp is small to ensure lots of individual attention for each child. Our average attendance each day is 15 children, with 25 being our max.

What is a camp day like?

Each day we participate in three movement classes, and an art class. Classes in art, jazz, tap, belly dance and circus arts are rotated throughout the week. (boys are excused from belly dance class!) In addition to these technique classes we also work on craft projects during our free time. We have water breaks between our classes and an hour lunch break at noon each day.

Who staffs the camp?

Our camp is run by our proprietor, Margaret Reynolds and a staff of adults, all of whom are professional dancers.

What about lunch?

Please bring a sack lunch to camp each day! We have a refrigerator, microwave, and small oven available to use. We are also happy to escort your child to CVS,

Subway, Starbucks, Smokin' Woody's or another neighborhood restaurant to purchase a lunch. \$6 is plenty of money for a purchased lunch. If you forget to send a lunch with your child, don't panic...we'll make sure everyone eats!

Can I visit my child at camp?

Yes! We have an open door policy. If you have the day off and would like to see your child in action just let us know! You are even welcome to join in the fun!

Does Belle Plaine Studio have AC?

Yes, and we're not afraid to use it! We maintain a very comfortable and cool environment, even during the hottest days. There is also cold water available.

What if I have a child with special needs?

Let's talk. If we can provide your child with a safe, fun summer experience we would love to have them. We have past experience not only as teachers but as parents. Our building is handicapped accessible.
